A) The RAILWAY CROSSING sign (crossbuck) means that you are at a highway/ railway crossing. STOP, LOOK and LISTEN for the train.


B) The MULTIPLE TRACK sign means there is more than one set of tracks at a crossing. Trains could be going in either direction on any track. BE CAREFUL!

C) When the LIGHTS are flashing and the BELL is ringing, STOP!


A train is coming.

D) The lowered GATE also tells you that a train is coming and you must STOP.


Don't go past the gates!

Circle the letters of the words on the word list. They may appear frontwards, backwards and diagonally. Can you find them all? The letters that are left will form a secret message. Can you find it?









A Multiple Track sign
