



- 1. Know your boat each boat has its own purpose. Make sure you use your boat correctly.
- 2. Always wear a life jacket while riding on a boat.
- 3. Make sure a responsible adult is operating the boat.
- 4. Ride a PWC only with an experienced adult driver.
- 5. Don't stand in a small boat.
- 6. Don't sit on the gunwale or bow of a moving boat.

WHICH ONES FLOAT?

Pick something you could toss to someone in trouble in the water.





- I. REACH: Hold on to the dock or your boat and reach your hand, a boat oar, a fishing pole, or whatever you have nearby to the person in the water.
- 2. THROW: If you can't reach far enough, toss things that float for the person to grab.
- 3. ROW: If you're in a boat, use the oars to move the boat closer to the person in the water, or call out to a nearby boat for help. Don't use the boat motor close to a person in the water, the propeller could injure them.
- 4. DON'T GO: Don't go into the water. Yell or go for help.
